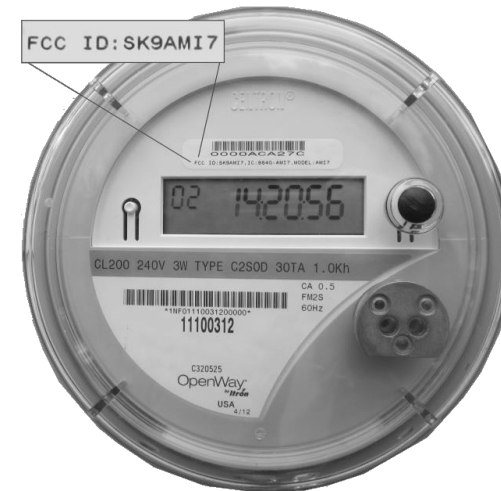
- c) When your security system engaged, departures, arrivals, sleeping, etc. is discernable Your meter can, despite National Grid telling Sen. Chandler differently collects home life patterns in 5-minute increments, the new generation collects 1-minute increments.
